§ 133-1. Prohibited acts.

From and after the passage and effective date of this chapter, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to place or throw or cause to be placed or thrown any garbage, bottles, cans, rubbish, wire, glass, cardboard, wood cartons, boxes, wastepaper or debris upon the highways, streets, alleys, ways, lanes and sidewalks of the Borough of Dormont.

§ 133-2. Violations and penalties.¹

Any person, firm, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than six hundred dollars (\$600.) and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of the fine and costs, shall be subject to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than thirty (30) days. In the case of firms, associations or corporations, the penalty may be imposed upon the partners or members thereof, and in the case of corporations, upon the officers thereof.
