§ 16-1. Revised plan.

Ordinance No. 1466 is hereby amended by the adoption of the revised emergency operations plan.

§ 16-2. Effect of provisions.

All other provisions remain in effect unless altered or amended by this chapter.

§ 16-3. Adoption of plan.

There is hereby adopted the "Dormont Emergency Management Organization and Emergency Operations Plan."

§ 16-4. Purpose.

This organization is created for the purpose of preventing, minimizing and alleviating injury or damage resulting from disasters caused by natural, man-made or other hostile actions.

§ 16-5. Membership.

The Fire Chief of the Borough is hereby appointed Emergency Management Coordinator and shall select the members of said organization. The members shall, however, include:

- A. The Borough Manager.
- B. The Dormont Volunteer Fire Department Officers.
- C. The Police Chief.

- D. The Police Department Supervisors.
- E. The Director of Medical Rescue Team South Authority.

§ 16-6. Creation and maintenance of plan; plan as guideline and reference manual; official plan.

- A. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall be responsible for the creation and maintenance of the document known as "The Dormont Emergency Management Plan" setting forth the areas of responsibilities for all municipal agencies and providing a system for unified and controlled command of the emergency scene.
- B. Said plan shall be used as the guideline of operations and the reference manual for all municipal agencies to insure that control and command of disaster situations are established.
- C. The Dormont Borough Council shall adopt said plan as the official plan for the municipality.

§ 16-7. Location and distribution of plan.

Copies of the Dormont Emergency Management Plan shall be available at all times at the following locations:

- A. Borough Manager's Office.
- B. Dormont Volunteer Fire Department.
- C. Police Department Desk.
- D. Police Chief's Office.
- F. Municipal Emergency Operations Center.
- F. Secondary Command Post.

§ 16-8. Approval of plan; conformity with county guidelines.

The Borough of Dormant does hereby approve, adopt and place into immediate effect the emergency operations plan. This plan shall be reviewed every two years to make certain that it conforms with the requirements of the Allegheny County Emergency Operations Guideline.
