

**Chapter 160**  
**POLES AND WIRES**

**§ 160-1. Inspection by borough; repair  
and removal.**

**§ 160-1. Inspection by borough; repair and removal.**

It shall be the duty of the Code Enforcement Officer of the borough from time to time to inspect all poles and suspended wires such as telegraph, telephone, electric light, electric railway and all other poles and all suspended wires in every and all the highways in the borough and report any and all defects therein to the Council in his or her regular monthly report. Whenever any such poles or suspended wires are discovered to require immediate repair or removal, the Code Enforcement Officer shall require the owner thereof to repair or remove the same within a period of time to be determined by him or her or to proceed at once to have the same repaired or removed as, in his or her opinion, the exigencies of the case and the safety of the public may require.
