#### § 26-1. Creation of position; compensation.

There is hereby created the position of Chief Inspector who shall have the powers and duties as hereinafter set forth. The Council is hereby authorized to appoint some suitable person to occupy this position and to fix the compensation for said appointee.

#### § 26-2. Building construction.

The Chief Inspector shall have all the powers and duties as set forth in Chapter 83, Building Construction, for the Building Inspector.<sup>1</sup>

#### § 26-3. Fire prevention.

The Chief Inspector shall have the powers and duties as set forth in Chapter 110, Fire Prevention, for the Fire Commissioner.<sup>2</sup>

#### § 26-4. Powers and duties.

The Chief Inspector shall have such other powers and duties as from time to time shall be delegated to him or her by the Council or to the Borough Manager.<sup>3</sup>
