ARTICLE I

Medical Rescue Team South Authority
[Adopted 10-1-1984 by Ord. No. 1325]

§ 39-1. Creation.

The Borough of Dormont hereby authorizes, directs and provides for the creation of a joint municipal authority, along with Castle Shannon Borough, Baldwin Township and the Municipality of Mt. Lebanon, pursuant to the Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, P.L. 382, 53 P.S. § 301 et seq. (the "Act"), for the purpose of providing emergency medical service and medical and ambulance equipment, facilities and service to the incorporating municipalities, and other communities at their request, and exercising all powers under that Act.

§ 39-2. Name.

The name of the joint municipal authority shall be the "Medical Rescue Team South Authority" (the "Authority").

§ 39-3. Term of existence.

The Authority shall be in existence for a period of 50 years unless sooner dissolved according to law.

§ 39-4. Governing board.

The governing board of the Authority shall consist of eight members, two of whom shall be appointed by each of the participating municipalities in the Authority pursuant to the provisions of the Authority's Articles of Incorporation and bylaws.¹

§ 39-5. Rights and powers.

The Authority shall have all the rights and powers granted to municipal authorities by the Act.

§ 39-6. Authority to execute articles.

The appropriate officials are hereby authorized to execute the Articles of Incorporation and all other documents necessary to effectuate the creation of the Authority under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.²

ARTICLE II
Enlargement and Continuation of Authority

§ 39-7. Joinder of new member.

The Borough of Dormont hereby authorizes and approves joinder and inclusion of the Borough of Green Tree as a constituent community of the Medical Rescue Team South Authority, Inc., with all rights, duties, privileges, obligations and appurtenances with and among the other constituent communities, including the Township of Baldwin, the Borough of Castle Shannon, the Borough of Dormont, the Municipality of Mt. Lebanon and the Borough of Whitehall, pursuant to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, as amended; the Pennsylvania Borough Codes, as amended; the Pennsylvania First Class Township Code, as amended; and the Pennsylvania Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law, Act No. 62 of 1972, as amended.

§ 39-8. Composition of Board.

The constituency and composition of the governing Board of Directors of the Medical Rescue Team South Authority, Inc., will be increased from its present number of 10 members to a new number of twelve members, with each constituent municipality appointing two members of said Board of Directors, pursuant to the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and bylaws of the Authority.

§ 39-9. Authority to execute documents.

The appropriate officials of the Borough of Dormont, including but not limited to the Borough Council President, the Borough Secretary-Manager, the Borough Mayor and the Borough Solicitor, are authorized to sign and execute all documents and to take all other actions deemed necessary, proper or expedient to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance No. 1479.

§ 39-10. When effective.

This Ordinance No. 1479 will become effective upon the occurrence of all of the following circumstances:

- A. The adoption and approval of ordinances similar to this Ordinance No. 1479 having the same operative provisions therein by all of the other constituent communities of the Authority and by the Borough of Green Tree.
- B. The compliance of the Authority constituent communities and of the Borough of Green Tree with all of the requirements of the laws, regulations and rules of the United States of America and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania relating to Green Tree's joinder in the Authority, including but not limited to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, as amended, including, in particular, § 3.1 of said Act; and the provisions of those Pennsylvania statutes and laws regulating, respectively, each of the constituent boroughs, township and home rule communities.
- C. Full and complete compliance of the Borough of Green Tree with all of the provisions of this Authority's Resolution No. 98-06, including but not limited to the provision of paragraphs 6(a) and 6(b), inclusive, of said Resolution No. 98-06, as amended.
- D. The enactment and adoption of this Ordinance No. 1479 by the Dormont Borough Council and the approval of this article by the Dormont Mayor.
