Part 1**Rules and Regulations****§16-101. Rules and Regulations Established.**

The following rules and regulations are hereby established for the use of all parks and recreation places owned or operated by the Borough:

A. Use of any park or recreation place by any organization or group shall not be permitted unless scheduled in advance by Council or its agent.

B. No person shall bring any alcoholic beverage or liquor into any park or recreation place or have or consume any alcoholic beverage or liquor in any park or recreation place.

C. No person shall bring any animal into a park or recreation place except on a leash, and all animals shall be kept leashed when in a park or recreation place.

D. No person shall build or maintain a fire anywhere in any park or recreation place except in a fireplace placed there by the Borough for cooking purposes, and the person who builds a fire as authorized by this Section shall remain in attendance at the fire until it is extinguished.

E. No person shall deposit or dispose of any refuse anywhere in the park or recreation place except in refuse containers placed there by the Borough.

F. No person shall camp overnight in any park or recreation place except by special permit issued by the Borough. The permit shall designate the time and place for camping and it shall be unlawful for the permit holder to camp in the park or recreation place at any other place or at any other time than designated in the permit.

§16-102. Penalty for Violation of Rules and Regulations.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense.
