§ 202-1. Written permission required for operation on private property.

From and after the effective date of this chapter, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motorcycle, motor scooter or bicycle with motor attached on private property other than that of the operator of such vehicle, unless written permission has been secured from the owner of the property upon which the vehicle is being operated.

§ 202-2. Violations and penalties.¹ [Amended 1-22-1997 by Ord. No. 265]

Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not to exceed \$600, plus costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, shall undergo imprisonment for a period not to exceed 30 days.
