§ 88-1. Adoption of standards.

A certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the Manager/Secretary of the Township of West Deer, being marked and designated as the “BOCA National Building Code/1999, Fourteenth Edition,” as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., as amended from time to time, be and is hereby adopted as the Building Code of the Township of West Deer, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided, and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said BOCA National Building Code as may be promulgated from time to time are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof; as if fully set out in this chapter.
