Part 1**Housing and Rooming House Regulations****§11-101. Adopted.**

There is hereby adopted by reference thereto, the Housing Code of the Allegheny County Health Department being Article VI, "Houses and Community Environment," of its rules and regulations as the same is constituted on the effective date of this amendment.

§11-102. Purpose.

The code adopted by this Section provides regulations for establishing minimum standards governing utilities, facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to make dwellings safe, sanitary and fit for human habitation, establishing minimum standards governing the condition and maintenance of dwellings, dwelling units, rooming houses and rooming units; fixing certain responsibilities and duties of owners, operators and occupants of dwellings, dwelling units, rooming houses and rooming units; requiring permits for the operation of rooming houses; authorizing preliminary area surveys of dwellings; authorizing the inspection of dwellings, and the vacation or removal of dwellings unfit for human habitation; and providing penalties.

Three copies of the housing code adopted by this Section shall be kept on file by the Borough Secretary for inspection by and use of the public and shall be marked with the words "Borough of West Homestead, Official Copy."
