

APPENDIX

The following ordinances and resolutions are no longer of general interest, primarily because their provisions were carried out directly after their enactment. Since they are mainly of historical interest, it has not been considered necessary to include their entire text. Instead, they are arranged in groups, according to subject matter, and within each group listed by title in chronological order. The content of the ordinances and resolutions is indexed, in all necessary detail, in the general index at the end of this volume. The annual budget and tax ordinances have been listed only in the "Key to the Disposition of Ordinances." Any person who desires to read the full text of any of the ordinances or resolutions may do so by consulting the original Ordinance Books on file in the Borough Offices.

A. Annexation of Territory

A-1. Annexing to the Borough of Millheim, Centre County, Pennsylvania, a section of Penn Township, Centre County, Pennsylvania (being a Second Class Township) adjacent to and east of said Borough and directing the proper officials of the Borough to comply with the acts of assembly in connection with said annexation. (Ord. 61, 10/3/1949)

B. Bond Issues and Loans

B-1. Provided for an election to gain support for nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.00) to erect an electric plant. (Ord. 21, 9/8/1910)

B-2. Provided for an election to gain support for a twelve thousand dollar (\$12,000.00) debt to construct and erect a municipal building. (Ord. 29, 9/19/1921)

B-3. Provided for the borrowing the twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) provided for by election in B-1. (Ord. 31, 2/20/1922)

B-4. Provided for a special tax of six (6) mills to repay the above loan. (Ord. 32, 2/20/1922)

B-5. Provided for an election to gain support for borrowing money for construction of a municipal swimming pool. (Defeated) (Ord. 89, 9/8/1960)

B-6. Provided for a fifty thousand dollar (\$50,000) debt to pay for water line replacement. (Ord. 135, 1/29/1979)

B-7. Authorizing the issuance of a general obligation note, series of 1994, in the amount of \$1,037,875. (Ord. 178B, 5/23/1994)

B-8. Authorizing the issuance of a general obligation note in the amount of \$1,760,000. (Ord. 179, 5/31/1994)

B-9. Authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds in the aggregate amount of \$1,574,500. (Ord. 182, 11/21/1995)

B-10. Authorizing the issuance of two general obligation bonds in the aggregate amount of \$1,037,900. (Ord. 185, 5/8/1995)

B-11. Authorizing the issuance of general obligation bond in the aggregate amount of \$300,000. (Ord. 227, 10/10/2006)

B-12. Authorizing and securing a general obligation note, Series A of 2007, in the principal amount of \$2,140,500. (Ord. 232, 10/16/2007)

C. Franchises

C-1. Granting use of right-of-ways to The Central Pennsylvania Telephone and Supply Company for the building, erecting and operating telephone lines on Borough streets. (Ord. 5, 1/10/1887)

C-2. Authorizing The Central Pennsylvania Telephone and Supply Company to erect and maintain poles for telephone lines in the Borough of Millheim, Centre County, Pennsylvania. (Ord. 10, 2/14/1898)

C-3. Authorizing the Central Commercial Telephone Company to erect and maintain poles for telephone lines in the Borough of Millheim, Centre County, Pennsylvania. (Ord. 12, 12/26/1898)

C-4. Granting a fifty (50) year franchise for water to J.G. Spangler of Mapleton Depot, Pennsylvania. (Ord. 16, 12/21/1903)

C-5. Exempting the Millheim Water Plant from municipal taxes. (Ord. 17, 6/20/1904)

C-6. Agreeing to supply funds for condemnation of needed property for gaining rights along Philips Creek and Turpentine Creek for the Water Company. (Res. of 7/18/1904)

C-7. Granting the State Center Electric Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain poles, wires, cables and fixtures, with the necessary conduits and supports, upon, over, along and under the streets, highways, footwalks, lanes, and alleys of the Borough of Millheim, for the purpose of furnishing light, heat and power, by electricity, for domestic, commercial and industrial purposes. D. Governmental and Intergovernmental Affairs

D-1. Authorizing the M.E. Congregation to build their church tower over the line sidewalk and over the house of Dennis Lose. (Ord. 4, 8/3/1895)

D-2. Authorizing J.P. Gephart to build an overhead porch to the curb line in front of his building on East Main Street. (Ord. 24, 9/29/1916)

D-3. Providing for the assessment and collection of two-thirds (2/3) of the cost of improving the streets and/or alleys in the Borough of Millheim, upon the owners of real estate abutting on said improvement by an equal assessment on the foot front basis, the Borough bearing the remaining one-third (1/3) share of the cost thereof; providing for making equitable adjustments for corner lots or lots of irregular shape; providing for giving of notice of such assessment to each party assessed; providing for the collection of assessments and providing for filing liens for all unpaid assessments. D-4. Authorizing the Borough to join with other local government units as a settlor of the Pennsylvania local government investment trust for the purpose of purchasing shares of the trust. (Ord. 201, 10/8/2001)

D-5. Authorizing the creation of the Penns Valley Regional Planning Commission. (Ord. 211, 11/11/2003)

E. Plan Approval

(Reserved to accommodate future ordinances)

F. Public Property

F-1. Authorizing the Town Council of Millheim Borough to purchase from the School District of the Borough of Millheim the lot of ground situate on Penn Street in said Borough whereon is erected a school building and town hall for five hundred sixty-five dollars (\$565.00). (Ord. 18, 7/18/1904)

F-2. Permitting the use of a room or rooms for town hall purposes in the Municipal Building to be erected by said Borough, by virtue of an ordinance passed the 19th day of September, 1921 and the consent of the Electors of said Borough at the Municipal election held November 8th, 1921 by the Ladies Civic Improvement Club of Millheim.

Providing for the payment by the club of the excess cost above twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) in the construction of said building and furnishing of said hall for the use of said Club and for indemnifying the Borough against loss by reason of such excess cost.
