Part 1**Rules and Regulations****§16-101. Park Hours.**

The Borough Park shall be closed to vehicles between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. of the following day. No person shall bring any vehicle into the Park between the hours specified herein, and all vehicles in the Park at closing time must be removed therefrom by the operators thereof.

§16-102. Camping Prohibited.

No overnight camping shall be permitted in the Park, unless permission is given by Port Matilda Borough Council.

§16-103. Motorcycles and Similar Vehicles Restricted.

Motorcycles, minibikes, mopeds, and other similar vehicles shall be permitted in the Park, but shall be restricted to the access road and the parking lot.

§16-104. Penalty for Violation.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.

Part 2**Fishing Regulations****§16-201. Compliance with State Law.**

All persons utilizing the banks of Bald Eagle Creek in areas located in Borough park lands for fishing purposes must otherwise comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Fish Commission and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
