**Part 1****Animal Noise****§2-101. Unlawful to Keep Noisy Animals.**

No person shall keep or permit to be kept, harbor or otherwise maintain any animal which shall disturb the quiet of any public street or other public place or of any private property. For purposes of this Section a noisy animal shall be defined as one or more animals which make noises habitually or one or more animals which vocalize in such a way as to be heard 15 minutes out of any 60-minute period, so as to constitute annoyance to a person of ordinary sensibilities.

**§2-102. Enforcement.**

Prosecution of such violation shall be by the police or code enforcement officers of the Borough and shall be made only after complaint by an inhabitant of the Borough. Such complainant shall appear at the time of trial for such violation and give testimony relative thereto.

**§2-103. Penalties.**

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.
