§4-101. Duty of Owner to Number Buildings

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Part 1**House Numbering System****§4-101. Duty of Owner to Number Buildings.**

It shall be the duty of each and every owner, trustee, lessee, agent, occupant or terre tenant of each and every structure, including residential housing and nonresidential structures, in the Borough to cause the same to be numbered in accordance with the system or plan of house numbering approved by the Borough and adopted herein.

§4-102. Identification Numbers.

Identification number shall be placed on a conspicuous part of every house, building or other structure in a manner such that said numbers can be easily seen and read from the street in front of such building or structure and in full view from the opposite side of the street. The numbers shall be Arabic of a permanent nature either of wood or noncorrosive metal at least 4 inches in height with a minimum stroke width of ½ inch. The numbers shall be in contrast with the immediate background.

§4-103. Numbers Not to Be Concealed.

No person shall cover any house number with any sign, material or other obstruction tending to conceal such number.

§4-104. Numbering System.

All numbers shall be as indicated on the numbering plat, a copy of which is available for inspection in the Borough office.

§4-105. Violations.

1. No person shall number or attempt to number any house or other structure contrary to the provisions of this Part and the plan which is hereby approved and adopted, nor shall any person alter, deface, remove or destroy any number required to be displayed by this Part.

2. No person shall fail or neglect to change or erect his house or building number in accordance with the provisions of this Part within 30 days after formal notification in writing by the Borough Secretary to complete such numbering.

3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute

a separate offense. [*Ord. 178*]
